Areas for improvement

There is a good range of learning trips or visits during school hours.

We try to ensure that every class has at least two trips during the school year. In the Autumn term Class Two went to Delaware Outdoor Education Centre and had a visit from the Police. Class one attended the remembrance service in Launceston. Class Three took part in the stay safe workshops and are planning a visit to link with their topic this term. The residential for Class Three has also been booked for the summer term. The whole school had a visit from an artist this week. There will be a whole school trip later in the year.

We will continue to look for opportunities for visits and visitors and involve pupils in decisions about places they would like to visit to support them with their learning. However, we do also have to consider costs of trips as we are aware this can be expensive for families.

The school lets me know how my child is doing.

We have three Parents Consultations meetings a year. These are each thirty minutes in length and they are an opportunity for both you and your child to discuss your child's learning in detail. We send out an annual report explaining your child's achievements and progress throughout the year.

We do also have an open-door policy and if at any time during the year you would like to discuss your child's learning further please make an appointment to see the class teacher.

The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year.

We put information about the curriculum on class dojo and the school website. Knowledge organisers are also sent out termly. We will continue to consider how we can support you further with your child's learning.
